The reconstructed section of the Barkly Highway will open for the two-way movement of traffic tomorrow, starting at 6am.

Motorists will now be able to travel through the construction site during the night.

Roadworks will continue at the site during the next two weeks.

Motorists are asked heed all warning signs, travel slowly and exercise extreme care when travelling through the work site.

Previously, trucks were only allowed to carry 80 per cent of their legal load limit. From tomorrow, trucks will be able to carry 100 per cent of this limit.

Until further notice, no overmass vehicles will be allowed to cross the rebuilt road.

Motorists are being urged to refer to the Department's Road Report website for updated road information on all Government-controlled roads, including graphical representations of restrictions on regional maps.
