

## Victoria River Bridge remains closed

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – is still closed to traffic. The water level is rising at 40mm each hour and the deck of the bridge is 4.6m underwater at its shallowest point. Rain continues to fall in the Victoria River catchment.

Motorist message alert boards in Kununurra and Katherine will be updated as conditions change.

Floodwaters have closed the Victoria Highway between Timber Creek and the NT/WA border. The highway is closed at the border.

Motorists should exercise extreme caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings. They will encounter potholes and washouts along the trafficable sections of the highway.

The road near Mathison Creek, at Skull Creek and Quart Pot Creek has been damaged by floods and motorists are urged to take care.
