

Victoria River Bridge to reopen

At the Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – water is now 0.7m above the deck of the bridge and is falling at the rate of 100mm each hour.

It is expected the bridge will reopen to traffic at 7am tomorrow. The motorist alert message boards in Kununurra and Katherine will be updated accordingly.

Due to the water saturation of the Victoria Highway, weight restrictions are still imposed on trucks travelling from the NT/WA border to Katherine.

Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.

Temporary repairs have been done on the Carpentaria Highway at October Creek - 170km east of the Stuart Highway. The reconstruction is not finished and motorists are urged to proceed with care when driving through the area.
