

## Water over Victoria River Bridge

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – remains closed to traffic. Water has risen 70mm and is 800mm over the highest point of the bridge. The water level, which is currently stable, is deeper in the centre of the bridge.

River levels continue to be monitored. The motorist alert message boards in Kununurra and Katherine will be updated accordingly.

The Victoria River Highway is now passable between Timber Creek and the Victoria River. The highway is still impassable between the Victoria River Roadhouse and Timber Creek, and Duncan Rd and the WA border.

Due to the water saturation of the Victoria Highway, weight restrictions are still imposed on trucks travelling from the NT/WA border to Katherine. Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.

Temporary repairs have been done on the Carpentaria Highway at October Creek - 170km east of the Stuart Highway. The reconstruction is not finished and motorists are urged to proceed with care when driving through the area.
