

Victoria River Bridge reopened

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – has been reopened to traffic. Vehicular access was allowed after the water level dropped sufficiently to allow motorists to negotiate the bridge safely.

The motorist message alert boards in Kununurra and Katherine have been updated to reflect the changed conditions.

The Victoria Highway is now passable between Katherine and the NT/WA border.

Due to the water saturation of the Victoria Highway, weight restrictions are still imposed on trucks travelling from the NT/WA border to Katherine. Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.

Temporary repairs have been done on the Carpentaria Highway at October Creek - 170km east of the Stuart Highway. The reconstruction is not finished and motorists are urged to proceed with care when driving through the area.
