

Victoria River Bridge closed again

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – remains closed to traffic.

Water levels are rising at 50mm each hour and the deck of the bridge is now 450mm underwater at its shallowest point.

Motorist message alert boards in Kununurra and Katherine have been updated to reflect the changed conditions.

Floodwaters have made the Victoria Highway impassable at Skull Creek – 40km east of Timber Creek. The highway is now passable at Saddle Creek - 100km west of Timber Creek – allowing access to the NT/WA border from Timber Creek.

Due to the water saturation of the Victoria Highway, weight restrictions are still imposed on trucks travelling from the NT/WA border to Katherine. Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.
