

Victoria River Bridge remains closed

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – is still closed to traffic.

The water level is rising at 80mm each hour and the top of the bridge is now more than 2m underwater. It is raining in the catchment.

Motorist message alert boards in Kununurra and Katherine are being updated to reflect the changed conditions.

The Victoria Highway from Timber Creek to the Victoria River is passable. The highway is also passable between Timber Creek and the NT/WA border.

Due to the water saturation of the Victoria Highway, weight restrictions are still imposed on trucks travelling from the NT/WA border to Katherine. Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.
