

## Victoria River Bridge remains closed

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – is still closed to traffic.

The water level is rising slowly and the deck of the bridge is 5.25m underwater at its shallowest point. Motorist message alert boards in Kununurra and Katherine will be updated as conditions change.

The Victoria Highway is impassable between Timber Creek and the NT/WA border due to flooding at Alpha and Saddle Creeks – 32km and 100km west of Timber Creek respectively. The border is closed.

Weight restrictions are imposed on trucks between Katherine and the NT/WA border. Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.

Motorists are urged to take care near Mathison Creek, at Skull Creek and Quart Pot Creek, where the road has been damaged by floods.
