

Victoria River Bridge remains closed

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – is still closed to traffic.

The water level is dropping 100mm each hour and the deck of the bridge is 1.8m underwater at its shallowest point. Motorist message alert boards in Kununurra and Katherine will be updated as conditions change.

The Victoria Highway between the NT/WA border and Timber Creek is closed. Barrier boards and road closed signs have been erected at the border. The highway is open between Timber Creek and Victoria River.

Weight restrictions are imposed on trucks travelling between Katherine and the Victoria River, and on trucks travelling between Timber Creek and the Victoria River.

Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.
