

## Victoria River Bridge may reopen today

The Victoria River Bridge - 200 km west of Katherine – is still closed to traffic.

The water level is dropping at the rate of 200mm each hour and the deck of the bridge is 1m underwater at its shallowest point.

It is expected the bridge will reopen to traffic later today. Motorist message alert boards in Kununurra and Katherine will be updated as conditions change.

The Victoria Highway between the NT/WA border and Timber Creek has been reopened to high clearance vehicles, such as trucks and 4WDs. The highway remains open between Timber Creek and Victoria River.

Weight restrictions remain on trucks travelling between Katherine and the NT/WA border.

Motorists should exercise caution at submerged floodways and stream crossings.
